Post Graduate Students

The basic mission of the South Royalton School is to provide a quality education for students from kindergarten through high school graduation. The Board of School Directors, however, recognizes that some adults who have attained a high school diploma may benefit from being able to enroll in courses being offered at the South Royalton School. Accordingly, the administration of the South Royalton School may permit residents of the Town of Royalton to take course work as postgraduate students without charge.

Admission for postgraduate study shall be at the discretion of the principal who shall consider the individual's past record and his/her educational needs and reasons for wishing to enroll, and the availability of space in the desired class(es). The decision of the principal shall be final.

Attendance by postgraduate students shall be permitted only at the high school level. The postgraduate student shall be present on the school campus only during the times of his/her class or classes unless explicit permission of the principal permits his/her presence at other specified times. No school-provided transportation will be available for postgraduate students nor shall postgraduate students ride the district's pupil transportation vehicles. The postgraduate student shall abide by all applicable school rules and requirements, including attendance rules, as stated in the school's student handbook. Inappropriate conduct may result in immediate loss of permission to attend the school.

Any postgraduate student may be excluded from further attendance at any time the Principal determines the student's continued presence to be detrimental to the best interests of the South Royalton School.
